

# Background Colours for Custom Page Layouts

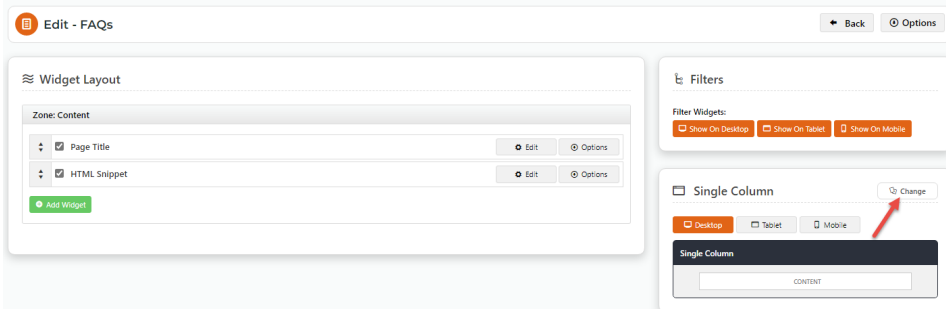

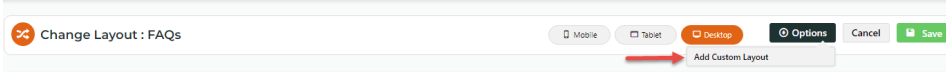
Custom Layout Creator needs to be switched on for your site by Commerce Vision.

To add a background colour to a custom page layout area:

1. Go to the page you want to edit (**Content Pages & Templates**).
2. Click **Change** on the Layout panel.

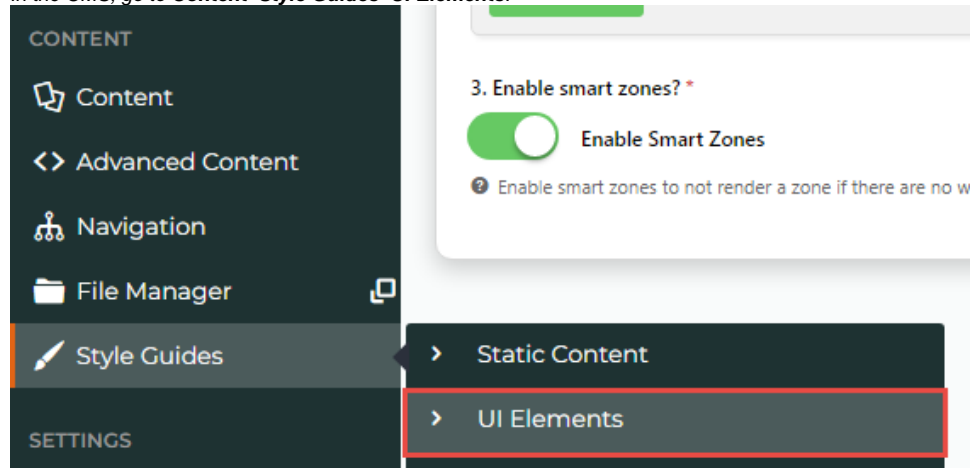


3. Hover over **Options**, then **Add Custom Layout**. (NOTE - If this is unavailable, Custom Layout Creator has not been enabled for your site. Contact Commerce Vision.)



4. In **Name Your Layout**, enter a suitable name for this layout.
5. Select **Add a Row**.
6. In the **Add New Row** modal:
  - i. **Additional Classes**: enter the colour code for the row based on your provided style guide. (See: **Content Style Guides UI Elements**)

1. In the CMS, go to **Content Style Guides UI Elements**.



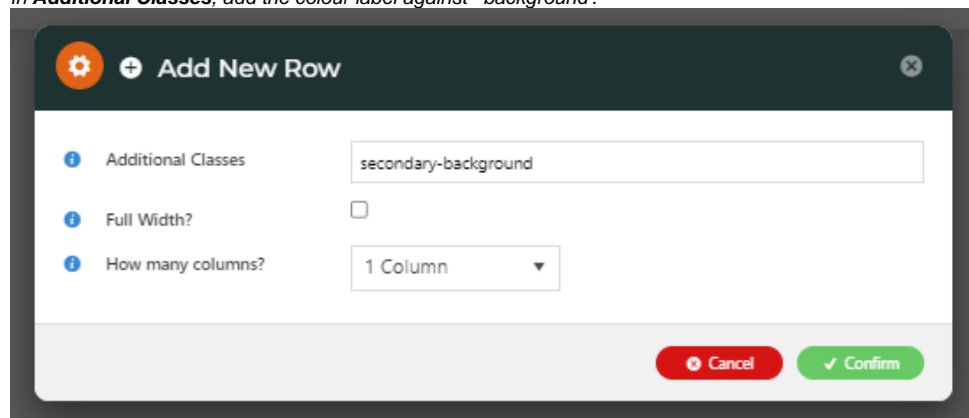
2. Go to your site's style colours. Here's an example.



3. Note down the label(s) against the colours.

- a. primary-background
- b. default-background
- c. secondary-background
- d. black-background
- e. white-background

4. In **Additional Classes**, add the colour label against '-background'.



ii. **Full Width:** Tick if the row is the full width across the screen.

iii. **How many columns?** Select the number of columns for the row.

7. Click **Save**.

8. Add widgets to the new layout zones.
