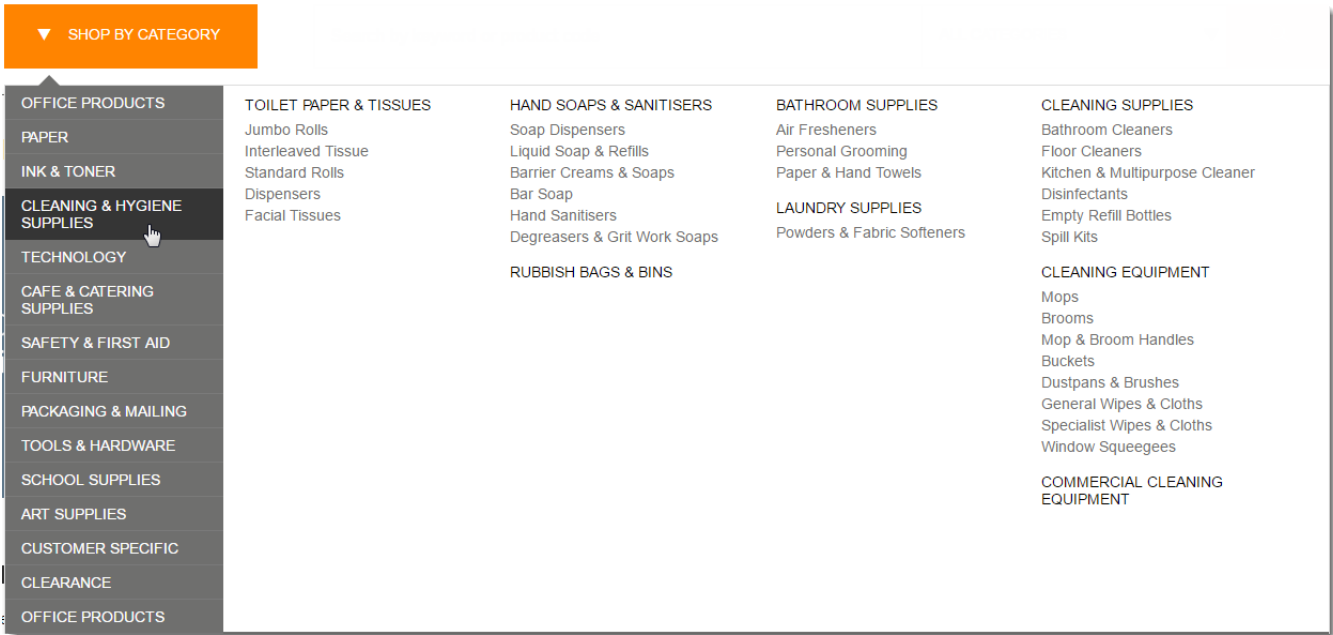


Category Menu Widget

Widget Use

Renders the top level product categories from a dropdown style button. Subcategories are displayed on the sidebar, changing as the user hovers over different categories in the menu.

Where can the Widget be placed?

The widget can be used in the following templates:

- Theme Layout Template

Widget Options

Option	Use	Comments	Available from Version
Description	A short description of the widget's use.	This description is added to the widget title. It makes the widget's use clear on the template page.	All
Layer	The layer the widget is valid for.	Use layering to limit widget content to certain groups of users. To use the same widget for more than one user group but with different options set, add the widget as many times as needed in the same zone. Then add layering to define the user group each time.	All
Button Label	Text displayed on the category dropdown.	Default: SHOP BY CATEGORY	3.88

Product Category Menu List	<p>Add each top level category that is not to be expanded by default. Use a comma to separate each category.</p> <p>Example: SX01,SX02,SX03</p>	The default is blank, which means all categories are expanded.	<p>4.31</p> <div>  Unknown macro: 'multiexcerpt-include' </div>
Maximum Number of Columns	Select the number of top level columns for the menu.	Maximum of four allowed.	4.37
