Widget Use

Renders the message body in the email sent to the Administrator when a new B2B user registration has been submitted with Auto Part Registration active.

Option	Use	Comments	Available from Version
Description	A short description of the widget's use.	This description is added to the widget title. It makes the widget's use clear on the template page.	All

Layer	The layer the widget is valid for.	Use layering to limit widget content to certain groups of users. To use the same widget for more than one user group but with different options set, add the widget as many times as needed in the same zone. Then add layering to define the user group each time.	All
Message Content	The text displayed by the widget in the email body. Placeholders can be used to insert customer and company details. If there is no data for a placeholder, it will be ignored.	Default: {emailAddress} has registered as a user for access to this website as an Account Customer. The account is currently disabled.
