Option	Use	Comments	Available from Version
Description	A short description of the widget's use.	<p>This description is added to the widget title. It makes the widget's use clear on the template page. it is also used as the header for the page.</p> <p>Default: User Account Status</p>	All
Layer	The layer the widget is valid for.	<p>Use layering to limit widget content to certain groups of users.</p> <p>To use the same widget for more than one user group but with different options set, add the widget as many times as needed in the same zone. Then add layering to define the user group each time.</p>	All
'Keep Active' Link Successful Message	Message when the user clicked the 'keep active' link before it expired.	<p>Default: Thank you. Your user login '{0}' remains active.</p> <p>{0} - placeholder for for user login id.</p>	2022.3
'Keep Active' Link Expired Message	Message when the user clicked the 'keep active' link after it expired.	<p>Default: Sorry, the link has expired. Please login to the website to stop deactivation of your user account.</p>	2022.3
