

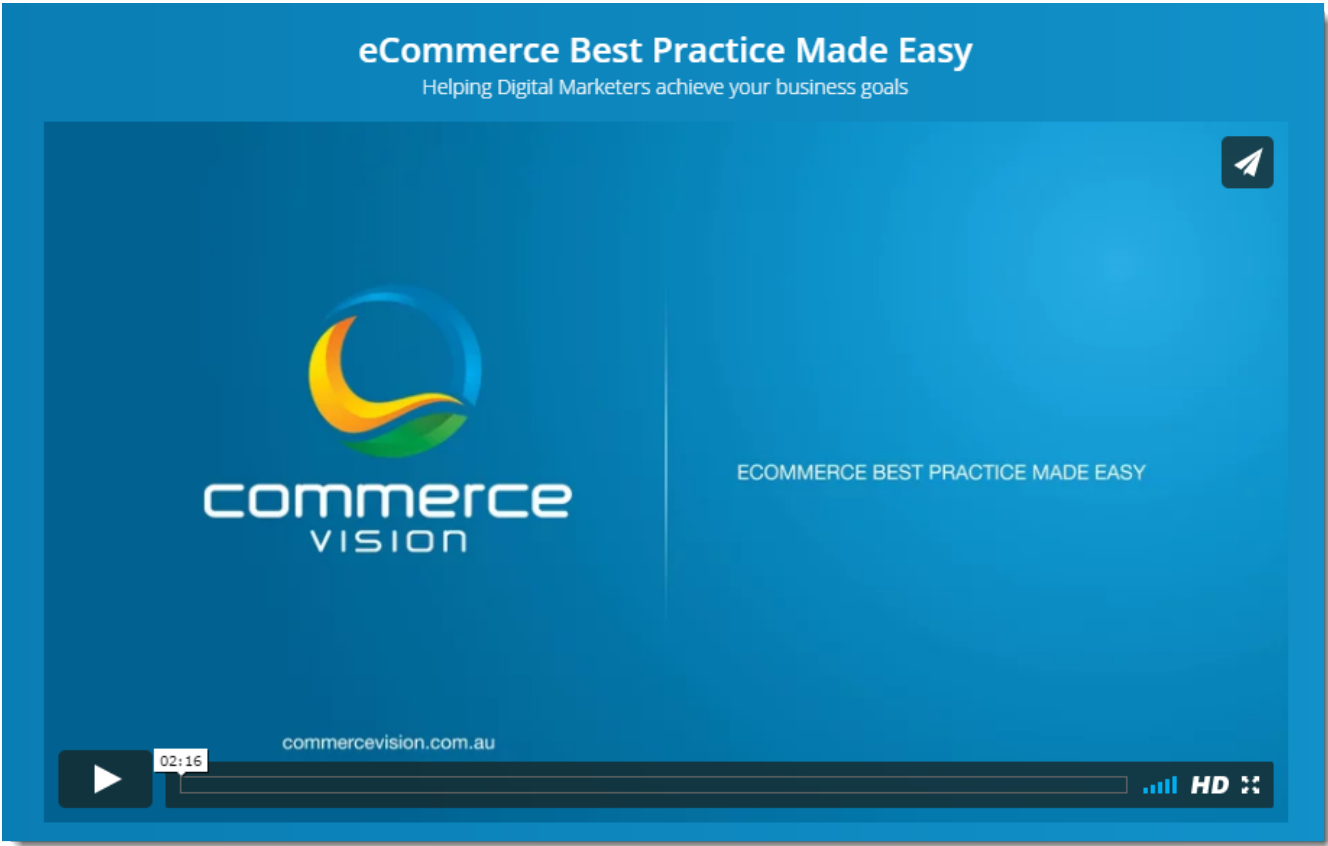
HTML Snippet Widget

Widget Use

Renders HTML code such as embed / tracking code, or third party scripts.

Please note - for content involving lists, tables, or formatted text (for example), the [Static Content widget](#) may be a better choice, as it supports your site's Style Guide.

The widget can be used in the following templates:

Widget Options

Option	Use	Comments	Available from Version
Description	A short description of the widget's use.	We recommended this field be updated so the widget's purpose is clear at a glance from the template page.	All

Layer	The layer the widget is valid for.	<p>The layering technology allows for the content to be shown to specific audiences.</p> <p>This is handy if the content is only valid for a certain type of user, or if the same widget is required for more than one audience, but different configuration is needed.</p> <p>The widget can be added to the zone more than once and the layer feature can determine which audience can see each widget.</p>	All
HTML	HTML code is entered here, to be displayed on the site in the widget's location.		All
Show On Mobile?	Determines whether the widget is displayed on a mobile device. If unticked, the HTML snippet will be hidden on mobile devices.	<p>Default is: ticked</p> <p>Untick to disable</p>	All
Right Align?	Pushes the widget to the right of the zone it is located in.	<p>Default is: unticked</p> <p>Tick to enable</p>	All
