

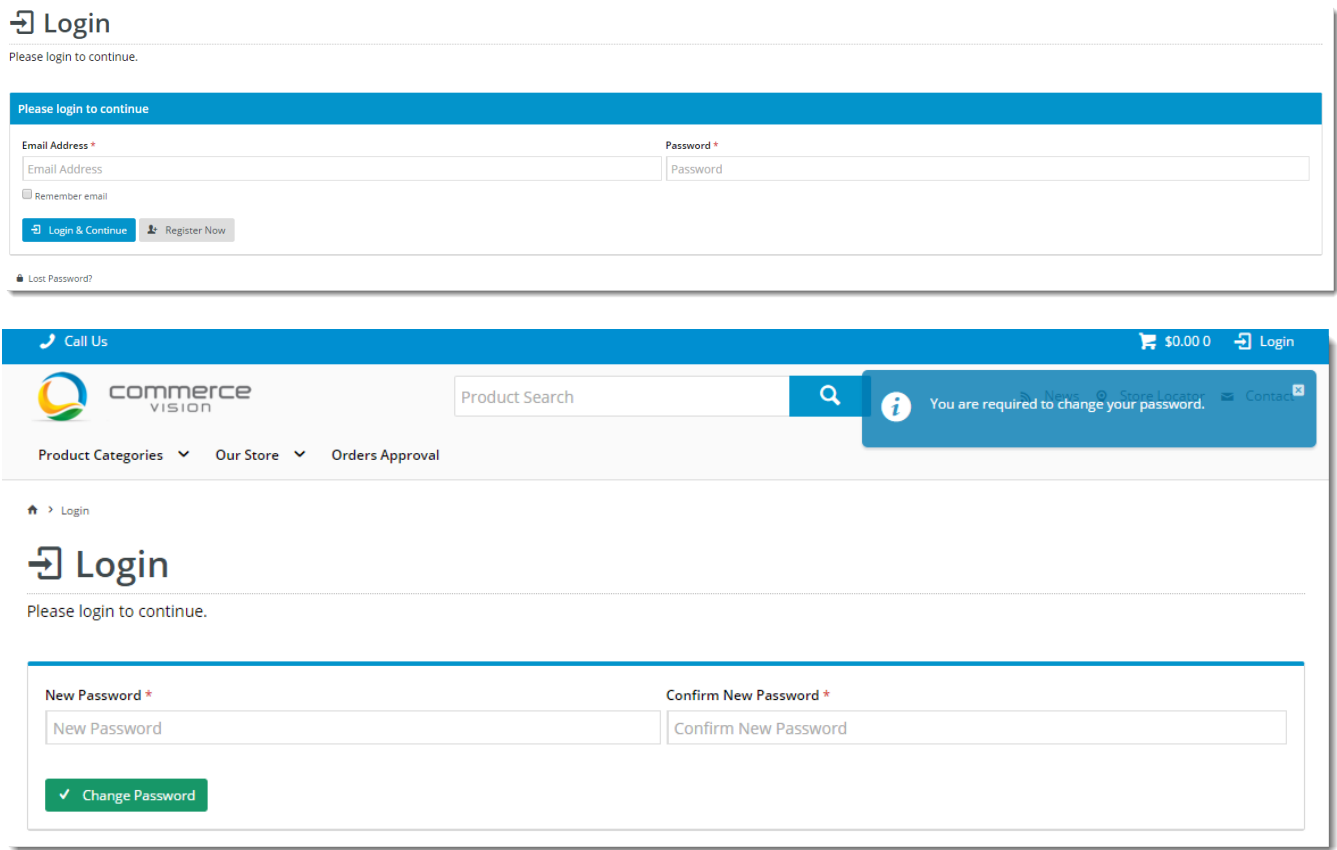
Login Widget

Option	Use	Comments	Available from Version
Description	A short description of the widget's use.	We recommended this field be updated so the widget's purpose is clear at a glance from the template page.	All

Layer	The layer the widget is valid for.	<p>The layering technology allows for the content to be shown to specific audiences.</p> <p>This is handy if the content is only valid for a certain type of user, or if the same widget is required for more than one audience, but different configuration is needed.</p> <p>The widget can be added to the zone more than once and the layer feature can determine which audience can see each widget.</p>	All
Title	The heading text displayed at the top of the widget.	Default is: Please login to continue	All
User Name Prompt	The label and placeholder text for the username field.	Default is: Email Address	All
Password Prompt	The label and placeholder text for the password field.	Default is: Password	All
Show Remember Me?	Determines whether the 'Remember Me' tickbox is displayed.	<p>Default is: ticked</p> <p>Untick to disable</p>	All
Remember Me Prompt	The label displayed next to the 'Remember Me' tickbox.	Default is: Remember email	All
Keep Me Logged In Prompt	The label displayed next to the 'Keep Me Logged In' tickbox.	Default is: Keep me logged in	3.78
Login Button Prompt	The text displayed on the Login button.	Default is: Login & Continue	All
Password Requires Change Message	<p>The message displayed to the user when a change of password is required.</p> <p>(For example, a new B2B user created by Customer Service, supplied with a temporary password, and required to change their password on first login.)</p>	Default is: You are required to change your password	All
New Password Prompt	The label and placeholder text for the new password field during a password change.	<p>Note - this applies when the password is set to force change by the user upon login.</p> <p>Default is: New Password</p>	All
Confirm Password Prompt	The label and placeholder text for the confirm password field during a password change.	<p>Note - this applies when the password is set to force change by the user upon login.</p> <p>Default is: Confirm Password</p>	All
Notification Email Prompt	The placeholder text displayed in the notification email input box.	<p>Note - this field will only display when the user's login ID is not in email address format. The system will prompt the user to enter an email address for notifications.</p> <p>Default is: Notification Email Address</p>	All
Change Password Button Prompt	The text displayed on the Change Password button.	Default is: Change Password	All
Change Password Button Icon	The icon displayed to the left of the Change Password button text.	<p>Default is: cv-ico-general-cycle</p> <p>Select via drop-down</p>	All
Password Changed Message	The message displayed to the user when they have successfully reset their password.	Default is: Password changed	All
Enter Password Message	The message displayed when the user clicks the Change Password button without first entering a password.	Default is: Please enter a password	All
Show Self Register?	Determines whether the Register button is displayed.	<p>Default is: ticked</p> <p>Untick to disable</p>	All
Register Icon	The icon displayed to the left of the text on the user registration button.	<p>Default is: cv-ico-general-user-add</p> <p>Select via drop-down</p>	All
Register Prompt	The text displayed on the user registration button.	Default is: Register Now	All
Show Forgot Password?	Determines whether the Forgot Password link is displayed, enabling users to request a password reset.	<p>Default is: ticked</p> <p>Untick to disable</p>	All
Forgot Password Icon	The icon displayed to the left of the Forgot Password link text.	Default is: cv-ico-general-lock	All

Forgot Password Prompt	The text displayed for the Forgot Password link.	Default is: Lost Password?	All
