## Widget Options

Option	Use	Comments	Available from Version
Description	A short description of the widget's use.	We recommend this field be updated so the widget's purpose is clear at a glance from the template page.	All
Layer	The layer the widget is valid for.	<p>The <a href="#">layering technology</a> allows for the content to be shown to specific audiences. This is handy if the content is only valid for a certain type of user or if the same widget is required for more than one audience but different configurations are needed.</p> <p>The widget can be added to the zone more than once and the layer feature can determine which audience can see each widget.</p>	All
Send Register Email	Determines whether the user will receive an email after registering an account	<p>Default: enabled</p> <p>Toggle to disable</p>	All

User Id Required As Email	<p>Determines whether the User ID must be in email format (eg someone@somewhere.com).</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>When ticked, the user's email address serves as their User ID and the 'Use Notify Email' option is disabled.</li> <li>When unticked, the User ID can be any value, and the 'Use Notify Email' option can be used to store the user's notification email address.</li> </ul>	<p>Default: enabled</p> <p>Toggle to disable</p>	All
Use Notify Email	Renders a field for the user to enter a notification email address for all communication from the website. This option is automatically enabled if the User ID is not required to be in email format.	<p>Default: enabled</p> <p>Toggle to disable</p>	All
Use Confirm Email	Renders the email address input box twice so that the user must enter it again as confirmation.	<p>Default: disabled</p> <p>Toggle to enable</p>	All
First Name Required	Determines whether the First Name is mandatory for registration.	<p>Default: enabled</p> <p>Toggle to disable</p>	All
Surname Required	Determines whether the Surname is mandatory for registration.	<p>Default: enabled</p> <p>Toggle to disable</p>	All
Show Phone Number	Renders the Phone Number field on the registration form.	<p>Default: enabled</p> <p>Toggle to disable</p>	All
Phone Number Required	Determines whether the Phone Number is mandatory for registration.	<p>Default: disabled</p> <p>Toggle to enable</p>	All
Prompt For Promo Material	<p>Renders a checkbox for the user to elect to receive promo material on registration.</p> <p><b>NOTE</b> - A field must exist for this value in the 'B2CRegistration' <a href="#">field group</a>.</p>	<p>Default: enabled</p> <p>Toggle to disable</p>	All
Show Terms and Conditions Checkbox	Renders a checkbox for the user to acknowledge and accept the site's Terms & Conditions.	<p>Default: disabled</p> <p>Toggle to enable</p>	All
Ticking Terms and Conditions Checkbox Required	Determines whether accepting the Terms & Conditions is mandatory for registration.	<p>Default: disabled</p> <p>Toggle to enable</p>	All
Show Validation Messages In Message Box	Determines whether an error message displays if the user attempts to register an account without entering valid content into mandatory fields. The error message will list the invalid fields.	<p>Default: enabled</p> <p>Toggle to disable</p>	All
Show Captcha for Registration	Determines whether a Captcha check is included in the register form.	<p>Default: enabled</p> <p>Toggle to disable</p>	All
Phone Number Regex	Tests entered phone numbers so ensure they are valid.	<p>Default: <code>/^0(2 3 4 7 8)d{8}\$/</code></p> <p><b>NOTE</b> - this should normally not be edited.</p>	All
B2B Registration Completed Message	Text that is displayed when initial registration of a B2B user is complete.	Default: Thank you for registering. Please allow up to 48 business hours (during peak times) for your login to be validated and activated. A confirmation email of your registration has been sent to you. When your login has been fully activated another email will be sent to you with details on how to login and complete the registration process.	4.04
B2B Registration Auto Approval Completed Message	Text that is displayed to the B2B user after they submit the registration form if auto-approval is on.	Default: Thank you for registering. A verification email has been sent to you. Once you verify your email you will be able to login and complete the registration process.	4.04
B2C Registration Verification Required Completed Message	Text that is displayed to the B2C user after they submit the registration form if <a href="#">verification via email</a> is on.	Default: Thank you for registering. A verification email has been sent to you. Once you verify your email you will be able to login and complete the registration process.	4.27
Customer Code	Required only if B2C Customer Code to be used is different from the default B2C Customer code.	Default: n/a	4.23

Hide Overriding Registration Customer Code	Overrides Customer Code for B2C user if 'Customer Code' has been set here.	Default: disabled Toggle to enable	4.23
Initial Role	Only required if the registered role will be different to the global B2C registration role.	Default: n/a	All
Customer Code Field	Required only if B2C Customer Code changes as the value here changes.	Default: n/a	All
Additional Register Field Columns	Determines how many additional field columns are present on the register page.	Default: 2	3.82

Details Section Title	The heading text for the user details section.	Default: Your Details	All
Details Section Icon	The icon that appears next to the user details heading text.	Default: cv-ico-general-pencil	All

Password Section Icon	The icon that appears next to the user password heading text.	Default: cv-ico-general-key	All

Password Mismatch Error Message	The red validation message displayed to a user who does not enter matching values in the password and re-enter password fields.	Default: Your passwords do not match. Please try again	All
Email Mismatch Error Message	The red validation message displayed to a user who does not enter matching values in the email and re-enter email fields.	Default: Your email addresses do not match. Please try again	All
Terms Checkbox Not Ticked Message	The red validation message displayed to a user who attempts to register without first accepting the Terms & Conditions.	Default: You must agree to the terms and conditions	All
Self-registration Not Permitted Message	The message displayed to users attempting to register when the site is not configured to allow self-registration.	Default: This site does not support self-registration of new users	3.82
Terms Checkbox Prompt	Text entered into this option will appear next to the terms and condition checkbox underneath the password fields.	Default is: I have read the terms & conditions	All
<b>Buttons</b>	<b>Use</b>	<b>Comments</b>	
Register Button Prompt	The text on the Register button.	Default: Register	All
Register Button Icon	The icon on the Register button.	Default is: cv-ico-general-user-add	All
<b>Prompts</b>	<b>Use</b>	<b>Comments</b>	
Password Rule Prompt	Text displayed above the Password prompt. You can add hints to the user (min. 6 characters) here.	Default: n/a	All
Terms Checkbox Prompt	Text for the Terms and Conditions checkbox.	Default: I have read the terms & conditions	All
Inline Terms and Conditions Text	Text for the Terms & Conditions of registration.	Default: n/a	All
<b>Captchas</b>	<b>Use</b>	<b>Comments</b>	
Captcha Version	Determines which version of captcha is used.	Default: Default Captcha Select another option from the dropdown list.	All
reCaptcha Site Key	(For reCaptcha v2 only.) Key that is created for your site.	Default: n/a	4.18
reCaptcha Site Secret	(For reCaptcha v2 only.) Secret that is created for your site.	Default: n/a	4.18
reCaptcha Theme	(For reCaptcha v2 only.) Determines whether the reCaptcha v2 background is light or dark.	Default: Light Select another option from the dropdown list.	4.18

reCaptcha Size	(For reCaptcha v2 only.) Determines whether the reCaptcha v2 image is normal or compact.	Default: Normal Select another option from the dropdown list.	4.18
reCaptcha Badge	This feature is not used here.
