


Widget option search

Office Star Cherry Finish Timber Visitor's Chair



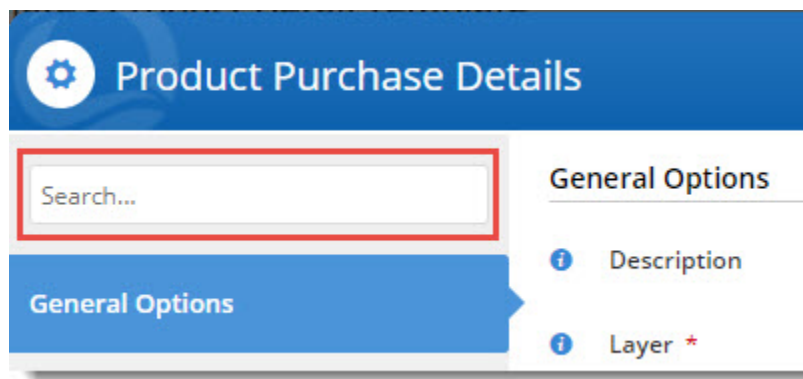
