Option	Use	Comments	Available from Version
Description	A short description of the widget's use.	We recommend this field be updated so the widget's purpose is clear at a glance from the template page.	All
Layer	The layer the widget is valid for.	<p>The layering technology allows for the content to be shown to specific audiences.</p> <p>This is handy if the content is only valid for a certain type of user, or if the same widget is required for more than one audience, but different configuration is needed.</p> <p>The widget can be added to the zone more than once and the layer feature can determine which audience can see each widget.</p>	All

Show Active And Inactive Reports Flags?	<p>By default, the system selects active reports only for Search. If toggled ON, the 'Show Active Reports' and 'Show Inactive Reports' checkboxes appear in the Search Reports function.</p>	<p>Default: ON</p> <p>ON: Both checkboxes appear. This allows users to find both active and inactive reports, or just inactive reports.</p> <p>OFF: Checkboxes do not appear. Users cannot select inactive reports.</p>	4.23
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Page Size	This sets the maximum number of pages to display search results.	Default: 20	4.23

4. Report Name Label	Heading for the report name in the Search Results section	Default: Report Name	4.23
5. Report Description Label	Heading for the report description in the Search Results section	Default: Report Description	4.23
6. Report Name Criterion Label	Heading for the report name field	Default: Report Name	4.23
7. Report Format Criterion Label	Heading for the report format dropdown list field	Default: Report Format	4.23

18. Clear Search Button Label	Text on button to clear current report search	Default: Clear	4.23
19. Search Button Label	Text on button to initiate search for report	Default: Search	4.23
20. Generate Button Label	Text on button to initiate report generation	Default: Generate	4.23
21. Subscribe Button Label	Text on button to subscribe to report. (Displays only after report generated and if report can be subscribed to)	Default: Subscribe	4.23
22. Cancel Button Label	Text on button to cancel report generation	Default: Cancel	4.23
23. Close Button Label	Text on button to close report selection criteria panel. (Displays only after report has been generated)	Default: Close	4.23
24. Reset Button Label	Text on button to clear report selection criteria fields. Display only after report has been generated)	Default: Clear	4.23

1. Search Title Prompt	Report Search section heading	Default is: Search	4.23
2. Search Results Title Prompt	Search Results section heading	Default: Search Results	4.23

4. No Reports Available Prompt	Text to display when no reports are found	Default: There were no reports found.	4.23

Report Generated Subscription Message	Text that appears to alert user that report has been generated and can be subscribed to. 	Default is: A new report has been generated and ready to subscribe.	4.23
Report Generated No Subscription Message	Text that appears to alert user that report has been generated but cannot be subscribed to.	Default is: A new report has been generated but not enabled to subscribe.	4.23
