

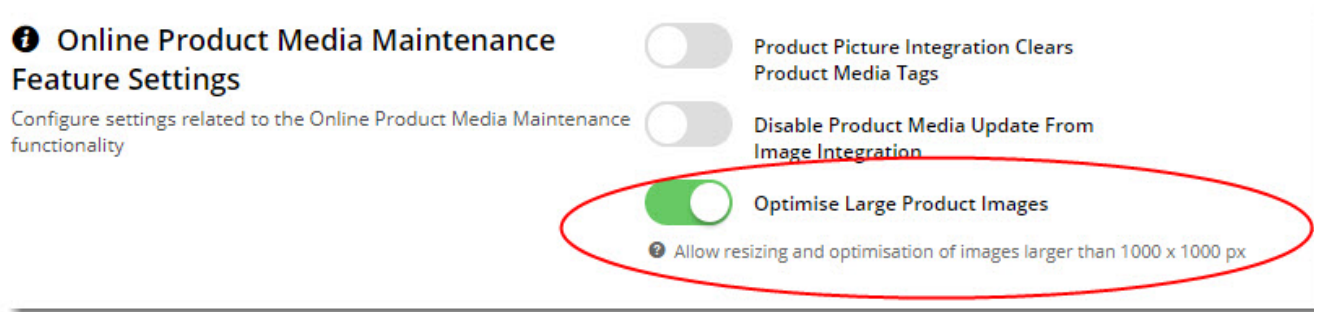
Disable large image optimisation

If you maintain your product images via the CMS, you may be aware that large images (1000 x 1000 pixels & larger) get optimised for the web when you upload them.

If you'd prefer this did not happen, you can now disable resizing and optimisation via a new flag.

Simply navigate to **Settings Feature Management**, and **Configure** the **Product Media** feature.

You'll see the new **Optimise Large Product Images** toggle - it will be on by default, but you can toggle off and click Save if you'd like to disable the function.
