

# Delivery Method Widget

## Widget Use

Renders a selector for the User to nominate a delivery method on a per-order basis. This selection determines the freight calculation method, which could be one of the following:

- Delivery method charge
- Standard Freight charge
- Standard Freight - restricted by carrier code
- Tiered charging based on a specified quantity

Layer	The layer the widget is valid for.	<p>The <a href="#">layering technology</a> allows for the content to be shown to specific audiences.</p> <p>This is handy if the content is only valid for a certain type of user, or if the same widget is required for more than one audience but different configurations are needed.</p> <p>The widget can be added to the zone more than once and the layer feature can determine which audience can see each widget.</p>	All
Always Display	Determines whether the widget is always rendered, under any circumstance.	<p>Default: OFF</p> <p>Toggle to enable</p>	3.83
