NOTE - Apple Pay is available in Safari on iOS version 10+ and macOS version 10.12+. If Apple Pay is not supported by the customer's browser, the options to select Apple Pay will not appear.





To configure Braintree Apple Pay Settings:




In Apple Pay Display Name, enter a meaningful name for your store. NOTE - If this is left blank, the User will see an error message and cannot use Apple Pay.




7. To save your settings, click Save.

When Apple Pay is enabled on your site...


In the Payments panel during checkout, 'Apple Pay' displays as an option under Payment Methods.




The User clicks on Apple Pay and an Apple Pay button is displayed.



The User clicks the Pay button and any saved cards in the User's Apple Pay Wallet are displayed for selection. A new card can also be entered. Once a card is selected, the User undergoes any required security check, e.g., entering their Passcode.
